The Nar-Anon Family Group is not affiliated with any outside enterprises and neither endorses or opposes any causes. Our primary spiritual aim is to recover from the devastating effect that addiction has had on our lives by practicing the 12 Steps ourselves, by welcoming and giving comfort to families of addicts and carrying the message to others.
